

COVID-19 SECURE

Even though government restrictions have eased, Covid-19 is still out there. With the safety of our community at the heart of The Nottingham Ballet School, we want to make sure that we are still doing everything we can to prevent the spread of the virus.

<u>Until further notice</u>, these regulations will stay in place with the aim to keep us all safe:

- Any person that enters the building will sanitise their hands upon entry and when leaving.
- Students are required to arrive at our venue ideally already dressed in the appropriate uniform for their class. However, there are toilet facilities available and therefore parents may get their child changed in there, should they need to.
- Students will be asked to hand sanitise upon entering the Main Hall and when leaving at the end
 of class.
- · Students will keep their belongings separate from others.
- Where possible windows and doors will remain open to ensure ventilation throughout the classes.
- Any student, parent or guardian that is displaying symptoms of Covid-19 should NOT attend classes.
- We ask that all students, parents and guardians continue to follow the NHS Trace and Trace and report any symptoms.
- In the event that a teacher has to self isolate or a lockdown, our classes will be taught online through Zoom. Class links will be sent out and our timetable will remain the same.
- If your child feels unwell during their class at The Nottingham Ballet School, and a member of staff suspects it is Covid-19, we will immediately call the emergency contact number provided by the parent/guardian. All parents/guardians are therefore asked to have their mobile phone switched on at all times.
- If your child is told to isolate following a class at The Nottingham Ballet School we wish that you inform us so that we can isolate the class and adhere to government legislation.

The safety of our students, parents and the wider community is of upmost importance to us and therefore we hope you can support these measures to help stop the spread of the virus.
